- VIII. **Call Meeting to Order:** By President Michelle Werth at 7:27 p.m.
- IX. **Pledge of Allegiance:** Led by Michelle.
- X. **Invocation:** Given by Chaplin, David Best.
- XI. **Special Guests:** None
- XII. **Introductions:** Each member present introduced themselves and told the group what they are most excited about this year.
- XIII. **Additions/Corrections to Agenda:** Added GMM Meetings to Management and Bowling Night to Membership Social Director. Mandie made a motion to approve the agenda with noted corrections. David seconded the motion. Motion passed.
- XIV. **Secretary's Report: Lea Alderman**
- A. **Monthly Report:** Handed out minutes from December GMM for review. Kendra made a motion to approve the minutes as written. Mandie seconded the motion. Motion passed.
- B. **Newsletter:** Lea is working on putting together a newsletter. She will get a January edition out next week. It will include a "Welcome Letter" from President Michelle and upcoming events. - A. **Monthly Report:** The 2010 Treasurer, Lisa Osthus, was unable to attend the meeting. She is still working on receiving some records. Will have a report in February.
- XVI. **Chairman of the Board: Kendra Werth**
- A. **Old Business:** None
- B. **Year-End Convention:** 2009 Year-End Convention will be held in North Platte on January 22 to 24, 2010. Kendra has registered 6 people for the convention. She has 2 extra rooms booked should other members decide to attend. This convention will have New Officer Training. There will be break-out sessions on such things as Blue Chip, CPG's, Parade, etc. Waverly will also be giving Brian Finch a Governorship.
- C. **Year-End Banquet:** The 2009 Year-End Banquet for the Waverly Jaycees will be held Saturday, February 27, 2010 at the Foundation Building. Social hour will begin at 5:00 p.m. followed by dinner and awards. We are still looking into a DJ for the event, as "Finch On The Run" is booked.
- D. **Region Lots:** Kendra has not heard of a scheduled date for this training. She will keep the membership posted.
